Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 2239: Catholics have a moral obligation to vote and to promote the common good and must fulfill that duty as a citizen.

So, the question is, do the positions of the candidate, for whom I'm voting, align with Jesus? ~ "I **am** the **way**, the **truth** and the **life**."

John 14:6

#### The 5 Non-Negotiables

- 1. **Abortion** (CCC 1273): Life begins at conception; therefore, abortion is murder of your offspring.
- 2. **Immigration** (CCC 2241):
  Authorities have a responsibility to allow migration under certain judicial conditions in regard to the common good of their country of adoption.
- 3. **Family** (CCC 2207): The family is the core of society.
- 4. **Religious Freedom** (CCC 2108): The right to religious liberty is a natural right of the human.
- 5. **Marriage** (CCC 1605): Holy Scripture affirms that one man and one woman were created for one another: "It is not good that the man should be alone." The woman, "flesh of his flesh," his equal, his nearest in all things, is given to him by God as a "helpmate"; she thus represents God from whom comes our help.

### Did you know you can study your ballot before the election?

Here's how -

- 1. Go to <u>SoulsAndLiberty.com/</u> Resources
- 2. Click on *your state*. You will be brought to a page on Ballotpedia.
- 3. Click on *Ballotpedia's Sample Ballot* in the left column.
- 4. Add your home and email addresses.
- 5. Click on *detailed*.
- 6. State Constitution Amendments will be at the top. (Language is very deceptive, so do your homework).
- 7. Study the candidates. Click on their names and look at his/her background and voting record. Find out who's running in your local elections and if there are any amendments to your state constitution. Are these candidates and amendments aligned with moral truth?
